5. How old was Jesus when his ministry started?
6. Who are 5 people in Jesus' family tree?
7. Where did Jesus go after he was baptized?
8. How long was he there and what happened to him?
9. How many times was Jesus tempted, and how did Jesus respond?
10. What prophet did Jesus read from in the synagogue?
11. How did the people respond to Jesus in his hometown?
12. How did demons respond to Jesus?
13. What did the people say about Jesus when they saw him casting out demons?
14. What did Jesus tell fisherman like Simon to do?
15. What was Simon's first reaction to Jesus?
16. What did the fisherman do when Jesus invited them?
17. What people did Jesus heal in chapter 5?
18. Why were religious leaders upset with Jesus?

For Second Year Class: Read Luther's Small Catechism on Baptism

1. What is baptism? What things are needed in order to have a baptism?
2. When were you baptized? Do you remember?
3. Do you need to use special water in Baptism? Why or why not? (What makes the water special?)
4. Why are we baptized? Or what does it mean to be baptized?
5. Are you always saved if you are baptized; or can you be baptized and not believe? Why or why not?
6. Can you believe and not be baptized? Why or why not?
7. Is it better to be baptized as a baby or an adult? Why?
8. Is it better to be sprinkled with water or to be dunked when you are baptized? Does it make a difference? Why or why not?
9. Write down one question to ask in class from the readings assigned.
