2. How was Jesus healing people when a crowd gathered around him?
3. According to Jesus, who are some people who are blessed?
4. Who are some of the people Jesus says “woe” to?
5. What does Jesus say we should do with our enemies?
6. What does Jesus say about judging and condemning others?
7. What did a centurion ask for Jesus to do?
8. What did a woman do to Jesus when he ate with Simon the Pharisee in Luke 7?
9. In Luke 8, Jesus tells a parable. What are 3 of the 4 different kinds of soil he describes?
10. According to Jesus, who are his mother and brothers?
11. What was the name of the demon possessed man Jesus healed?
12. How did Jesus get rid of the demons?
13. Who touched Jesus’ cloak and what happened?
14. What happened to Jarius’ daughter?

3. What are the two main elements in the Holy Communion and what do they represent?

6. How do we prepare for Communion?
7. Who can take Communion?
8. How often should we celebrate Communion, and why?
9. What age do you think people should be before taking Communion, and why?
10. What does Communion mean to you?
