11. Where was Jesus headed?
12. What instructions did Jesus give to the men he sent ahead?
13. What did Jesus do as soon as he arrived at the temple?
14. What did Jesus say about paying taxes?
15. What is one of the questions the chief priests and leader asked Jesus in the temple?
